



Using a web such as the one above allows teachers to adjust and adapt the learning experiences to meet the needs of individual children. Although the same web is used as a base for all HighReach curricula, the level of investigation within each age group will vary dramatically. For instance, when exploring the subtopic Trucks Deliver in Month 5, older children may explore exactly how tanker trucks help get gasoline to gas stations and how the design of these trucks makes them special. In addition, they may talk about the special signs and symbols on these types of trucks and what they mean. Toddlers, on the other hand, may only note that milk can be hauled by these types of trucks.

The learning experiences developed for each curriculum support the skills and objectives appropriate to the age group for which it is written. Toddlers, for instance, may note the colors of toy dump trucks while they push them around the classroom. Older children may compare how much dirt several toy dump trucks can hold and then put this information on a simple bar graph.
